Brief History: Cooreei Pty Ltd is a beef cattle enterprise consisting of 5500 acres of coastal grazing country, 3800 acres at Dungog (purchased in 1850) and 1700 acres in the Gloucester district (purchased in 2007). 400 commercial cows have been traditionally run at Dungog, with weaner steers sent to Gloucester for backgrounding. The steers are finished at Gloucester or Dungog, season dependent (MSA grass-fed weights of average 320kg dressed, with a compliance rate of 93%). Cull heifers are also finished at Dungog (MSA grass-fed weights of average 270kg dressed, with a compliance rate of 91%). On both blocks, country varies from river flats (minimal) through to undulating and steep open grazing ridges, out to coastal bush.

Angus cattle were introduced to the predominately Hereford cross herd in 1988. Cooreei Pty Ltd now consists of 300 angus cows, and 100 crossbred cows. Foundation Angus sires were predominately purchased from Main Camp, Forres, and Sugarloaf Angus studs.

Since 2007, artificial insemination of Angus sires has been used over the Angus heifers and the better performing Angus cows to breed bulls for in-herd use and paddock sales of surplus sires. We aim to breed soft, docile, easy-doing cattle with good width and conformation (especially broad strong muzzles and correct leg sets), focusing on progeny's ability to finish on grass.

Reasons for selling 20-month-old bulls:

They settle in to a new home and mate up with older bulls easily

They're big enough and old enough to use in an autumn joining

The bulls – 100% pasture raised, fed home grown ryegrass/clover silage in winter

All bulls have been vaccinated for 3 Day Sickness, Vibriosis, Pestivirus and 7-in-1. They all passed semen quality and structural soundness tests conducted by Dr Steven Marjlik (Barrington Veterinary Group) on the 4th February 2025.

All bulls have been tested free of the Developmental Duplication (DD) gene by Neogen Australia

Lot 1 - 351 is by Shiefelbein Showman 338, out of R41 (a larger framed but feminine, docile, now 10-year-old Ardrossan Admiral granddaughter). 351 is long and deep bodied right through, with a great disposition. 351 is thick-set from nose to tail. These traits, combined with a neat tail-set and good neck extension, mean 351 will breed you both top females and heavy steers (20 months).

Lot 2 - 316 is by Shiefelbein Showman 338, out of Pu16 (a thick made but productive now 9-year-old Banquet Abode/Booroomooka Inspired daughter). 316 displays the traits expressed in our ideal Angus bull – quiet, thick made with a soft smooth skin. He is really well balanced, stands square with a strong topline, good spring of rib and large scrotal capacity. 316 will be an early gestation sire, being born himself at 274 days gestation (19.5 months). We kept a son out of Pu16 a few years ago, and his calves are impressive.

Lot 3 - 375 is by Urban Rock Solid, out of W75 (a larger framed but feminine, now 5-year-old Remitall Sizzler granddaughter). 375 is super quiet, with a slick soft skin. Plenty of length and depth in this bull, and also displays a heavy hindquarter. Early gestation at 274 days (19 months).

He is super quiet, with good length, extra gut room and a soft skin. Plenty to admire about this sire (19 months).

Lot 5 - 315 is by Shiefelbein Showman 338 out of G15 (a moderate, smooth skinned Sitz Bull Durham granddaughter). 315 displays plenty of thickness through the stifle, with good width in the pins, and extra length from hips-to-pins. He also carries a stout amount of bone (18.5 months).

Lot 6 - 352 is by Shiefelbein Showman 338, out of R52 (a moderate but deep bodied, now 10-year-old SAV Final Answer granddaughter). 352 is a more moderate Showman son who exhibits good muscling throughout his frame, accompanied by a smooth skin, extra gut-room and large scrotal capacity. R52 has had a bull calf worth keeping every-time she's produced a male calf, and produced our top selling lot in the 2022 sale (19 months).

He is soft skinned, with a thick tailhead as well as ideal hooding around the eyes (20 months).

He's super quiet, with a tidy sheath, good scrotal capacity, and a broad muzzle. Early gestation at 277 days (20 months).

Lot 9 - 394 is by Killain Rainman out of Br55 (a square-made, moderate now 4 -year-old S Chisum granddaughter). 394 is Br55's first calf (calving as a 2-year-old). 394 is super quiet at home, and always comes up to the quad bike! He displays plenty of thickness right along his top-line, with added hindquarter muscle expression. He has good hooding around his eyes and a smooth soft skin. Should suit heifer joining (18.5 months).
