

Cooreei Pty Ltd Angus Bull Sale

Maitland Regional Saleyards

Brief History: Cooreei Pty Ltd is a beef cattle enterprise consisting of 5500 acres of coastal grazing country, 3800 acres at Dungog (purchased in 1850) and 1700 acres in the Gloucester district (purchased in 2007). 400 commercial cows have been traditionally run at Dungog, with weaner steers sent to Gloucester for backgrounding. The steers are finished at Gloucester or Dungog, season dependent (MSA grass-fed weights of average 320kg dressed, with a compliance rate of 93%). Cull heifers are also finished at Dungog (MSA grass-fed weights of average 270kg dressed, with a compliance rate of 91%). On both blocks, country varies from river flats (minimal) through to undulating and steep open grazing ridges, out to coastal bush.

Angus cattle were introduced to the predominately Hereford cross herd in 1988. Cooreei Pty Ltd now consists of 300 angus cows, and 100 crossbred cows. Foundation Angus sires were predominately purchased from Main Camp, Forres, and Sugarloaf Angus studs.

Since 2007, artificial insemination of Angus sires has been used over the Angus heifers and the better performing Angus cows to breed bulls for in-herd use and paddock sales of surplus sires. We aim to breed soft, docile, easy-doing cattle with good width and conformation (especially broad strong muzzles and correct leg sets), focusing on progeny's ability to finish on grass.

Reasons for selling 20-month-old bulls:

They settle in to a new home and mate up with older bulls easily

They're big enough and old enough to use in an autumn joining

The bulls - 100% pasture raised, fed home grown ryegrass/clover silage in winter

All bulls have been vaccinated for 3 Day Sickness, Vibriosis, Pestivirus and 7-in-1. They all passed semen quality and structural soundness tests conducted by Dr Steven Marjlik (Barrington Veterinary Group) on the 30th March 2026. They have also all been tested free of the Developmental Duplication (DD) gene by Neogen Australasia.

Please note that the daily weight gain on all bulls has reflected the consecutive tough seasons they have experienced since birth, as nearly all producers in the Lower Hunter and surrounds could all appreciate.

Lot 1 - 451 is by SAV Scalehouse, out of R51 (a moderate framed, high milking, docile, now 11-year-old Ardrossan Admiral granddaughter). 451 is long and heavy-set right through, and carries himself very well for a bigger bull. He has a slick, soft coat, with extra fill over the shoulders, and plenty of meat down the hindquarters. 451 is the heaviest bull in the draft, and has had exceptional weight gain since birth (21 months).

Lot 2 - 452 is by SAV Scalehouse, out of R52 (a moderate but deep bodied, now 11-year-old SAV Final Answer granddaughter). 452 is a very well-balanced bull, with a strong, thick top-line, ideal hip-to-pin slope, and a well hooded eye. He exhibits a good spring-of-rib, and is extremely docile. This is the 6th bull that R52 has produced (and we've kept entire), including the sale topping bull from the 2022 Cooreei bull sale (21 months).

Lot 3 - 407 is by SAV Scalehouse, out of Y07 (a moderate framed, docile now 9-year-old SAV Prosperity daughter). 407 is deep barrellled, with a strong top-line. He is deep in the flank and hindquarter, with good bone, and a slick, smooth coat (21 months).

Lot 4 - 470 is by Urban Rock Solid, out of G04 (a thick, easy-doing, now 8-year-old SAV Resource/S. Chisum daughter). 470 exhibits thickness right through the pins and stifle area. He has plenty of gut room and a good spring-of-rib, with a strong top-line and a long hip-to-pin. 470 is a half-brother to the sale topping bull from 2025 (21 months).

Lot 5 - 482 is by Cooreei Sizzler 567 (Remitall Sizzler), out of Pu82 (a moderate but deep bodied, now 10-year-old Banquet Abode granddaughter). 482 is a beautifully balanced bull, with a soft, shiny coat. He is an easy-doing bull, with good bone and strength through the hindquarters. He also displays a deep barrel, and a well hooded eye (20 months).

Lot 6 - 402 is by Cooreei 016 (Remitall Sizzler/Banquet Abode) out of Y02 (a large framed, good milking BT Right Time 24J daughter). 402 is a super quiet, long bodied bull, with a soft, slick coat. He displays a smooth shoulder, with a long hip-to-pin, and extra gut capacity (21 months).

Lot 7 - 415 is by Cooreei Sizzler 567 (Remitall Sizzler) out of Pu15 (a moderate framed, now 10-year-old Te Mania Emperor daughter). 415 is a moderate, but tidy bull. He is well balanced with deep hindquarters and ample thickness throughout his frame (20 months).

Lot 8 - 476 is by Cooreei 024 (Cooreei Sizzler 567) out of R76 (an easy-keeping, well uddered, now 6-year-old S. Chisum granddaughter). 476 is a very easy-doing bull, with a deep strong jaw and a super soft skin (20 months).

Lot 9 - 423 is by SAV Scalehouse, out of R23 (a square-made, strong topped now 11 -year-old Remitall Sizzler daughter). 423 is an athletic bull who covers the ground with ease. He has an attractive front-end and a neat tail set, with good hip-to-pin slope. His mother has always reared a good calf (21 months).

Lot 10 - 459 is by SAV Scalehouse, out of Y59 (a long, neat uddered now 9-year-old Connealy Final Product daughter). 459 is a flat-topped bull, with a neat tail set and good hip-to-pin slope. He has a longer neck extension, large scrotal capacity, and covers himself well when travelling (21 months).

Lot 11 - 433 is by Urban Rock Solid, out of G33 (a moderate, good uddered, now 8-year-old Mohnen Dynamite granddaughter). 433 is a well-balanced bull, with an attractive front-end. He also exhibits a soft skin and an ideal hip-to-pin slope. 433 would suit a heifer joining (20 months).

Lot 12 - 443 is by Cooreei 016 (Cooreei Sizzler 567) out of Y43 (a moderate, now 9-year-old Connealy Final Product granddaughter). 443 is a well-balanced bull, with a tidy tail set and ideal hip-to-pin slope. Would suit a heifer joining (20 months).
